¹ Constructs is the only required course for part time students that must be taken in the spring of the second year. Because part time students can choose to take their clinic in either the 5th or 7th semester, there are different options for how they may choose to sequence the rest of their courses. Therefore, what follows is a list of required courses that must be taken prior to graduation. ² Public Institutions is usually offered in the spring semester. When possible, it will be also offered in the fall semester in the

³ Lawyering Seminar III options are only offered in the spring semester. Students may opt to take Lawyering Seminar III in either their 4th or 6th semester depending on when would take Clinic.

⁴ Professional Responsibility is a required course for graduation that may be taken in the second or third year. Credits vary depending on the semester it is offered (Fall/Spring = 2 credits; Summer = 3 credits). There is at least one section of Professional Responsibility offered every semester in the evening.

⁵ Core Doctrine/ALA is a required course. However, students can opt out of if their cumulative GPA at the end of the 7th semester is 3.3 or above. The 5 credit option is only granted in special circumstances with permission of the Academic Affairs Office.

⁶ Four bar electives are required. Not all bar electives are offered every semester. Students can opt out if their cumulative GPA at the end of the 4th semester is 3.3 or above.
