AUDIT FORM

- 1. A student must formally register for a course and pay applicable tuition and fees.
- 2. A student will not receive credit or a grade for an audited course. An audited course cannot later be converted to a graded course. You may not subsequently take the same course for credit.
- 3. The credit equivalent of the audited course may not cause the student's course load to exceed the maximum allowable credits.
- 4. A student may register to audit a course during the registration period, but not later than thelast day of the add period. Audited courses dropped after the applicable drop period will be reflected by a "W" on the student's transcript.
- 5. Attendance is required of auditors, however, since auditors do not receive grades, they are excused from taking examinations and do not have to submit work.
