

CUNY Law School Dual Degree Program Guide

CUNY Law School offers three dual degree programs:

- JD/MPA in Law and Public Accountability with the John Jay College of Criminal Justice;
- JD/MA in Forensic Psychology, with the John Jay College of Criminal Justice; and
- JD/MIA with City College's Colin Powell School for Civic and Global Leadership

Each of the Master's programs has slightly different requirements, but each dual degree program allows a student to earn the two degrees in less time than it would take to complete each separately, because the programs have agreed to recognize some of the classes from the other program toward its degree.

Here are answers to common questions:

Admissions:

- Students must indicate on their application whether they are interested in a dual degree program, and if so, which one.
- Students must be admitted separately to each program. Students can get law school credit for classes taken at one of the partner institutions for classes taken **after** they have matriculated at the law school.

Registration:

- Students must provide a copy of their letter of acceptance offering admission to the partner school as soon as they determine that they will enroll in the dual degree program.
- Students must meet with an advisor at each of the partner schools to approve their program plan before the end of their 1L year. Students must complete the **Dual Degree Program Request Form** indicating that the advisor at each school has approved the program plan and listing their projected schedule for completing the requirements for each degree. The form must be signed by the Associate or Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs, and must be submitted to the **Registrar's** office.
- Students can take classes at the school not designated as their "home" school through the CUNY "E-Permit" process.

Financial aid:

- Students must apply for financial aid to the school designated as their "home" school for the academic year.

Tuition:

- Students will pay tuition based on the tuition scale of the school designated their "home" school for the academic year.
